The Development Permit application for Signs, installation of two (2) illuminated fascia signs and relaxation of the maximum horizontal direction has been **conditionally-approved** by the Development Officer subject to the listed conditions below **(PLEASE READ ALL CONDITIONS)**:

Description:

- 1. That installation of two (2) illuminated mounted fascia signs may be installed on the subject parcel in general accordance with the site plan and signage details, as prepared by Jones Neon Display, Revision: R4, dated February 26, 2025, and submitted with the application and includes:
 - i. Two (2) signs: "pet valu; distribution centre", approximately 17.45 sq. m (187.83 sq. ft.) in area), on the east and western building facades; and
 - ii. That the maximum horizontal direction of the signs shall be relaxed from **3.00 m** (9.84 ft.) to 6.46 m (21.19 ft.).

Permanent:

- 2. That the signs shall be kept in a safe, clean, and tidy condition at all times.
- 3. That the signs shall be maintained in accordance with the design drawings and site plan as submitted with the application.
- 4. That all on-site lighting, including private, site security and parking area lighting, shall be designed to conserve energy, reduce glare, and reduce uplight, in accordance with Section 27 of the County's Land Use Bylaw C-4841-97, as regulated by Direct Control District 99. All lighting shall be full cut-off (shielded) and be located and arranged so that no direct rays of light are directed at any adjoining properties, that may interfere with the use and enjoyment of neighbouring lands, or interfere with the effectiveness of any traffic control devices or the vision/safety of motorists.
- 5. That if the development authorized by this Development Permit is not commenced with reasonable diligence within 12 months from the date of issue, and completed within 24 months of the issue, the permit is deemed to be null and void, unless an extension to this permit shall first have been granted by the Development Officer.
