Water Act NOTICE OF APPLICATION

Notice is given that Rocky View County has filed an application under the provisions of the *Water Act* for the work associated with the installation of 4062 meters of flood protection infrastructure and consists of five barrier segments:

- East Bragg Creek Flood Barrier, length = 2422 m;
- West Creek Bragg Flood Barrier – South, length = 590 m;
- West Bragg Creek Flood Barrier – North, length = 330 m;
- Yoho Tinda Flood Barrier, length = 580 m; and
- Bragg Creek Dike, length = 140 m

on the Elbow River at NW-12-023-05-W5M, NE 13-023-05-W5M, NE 12-023-05-W5M and SE 13-023-05-W5M and Bragg Creek at NW12-23-05-W5M, in the Hamlet of Bragg Creek.

 - the application number: **001-00397687**.
 - describe concerns that are relevant to matters regulated by the *Water Act*.
 - explain how the filer of the concern will be directly affected by the activities proposed in the application.
 - provide the legal land location of the land owned or used by the filer where the concerns described are believed to be applicable.
 - state the distance between the land owned or used and the site in the application.
