


## CALGARY METROPOLITAN REGION BOARD (CMRB) AND THE CITY OF CALGARY

## What is Calgary Metropolitan Region Board (CMRB)?

Rocky View County is one of eight municipal members of the Calgary Metropolitan Region Board (CMRB).

The Board is tasked with developing a long-term plan for managed and sustainable growth in the Calgary region.

To ensure this, the CMRB uses the Regional Growth Plan, Servicing Plan, and Regional Evaluation Framework (REF), which came into effect on August 15, 2022




## Rocky View County/City of Calgary Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP)

In addition to the policies of the ASP, the collaboration and coordination of land use matters within Springbank is guided by the Rocky View County/City of Calgary Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP). Throughout the implementation of the Springbank ASP, the County will maintain open communication with The City, circulating relevant local plans and development applications, sharing technical information, and identifying cross boundary issues and opportunities.
