Keep a Lid on It



Cart lids must be fully closed. Overfilled carts may not be collected, as this can lead to spills and litter throughout the community.

Sort your waste correctly into the black, blue, and green carts, and place your carts out by 7 a.m. every week for collection to keep them from being overfilled. Ensure they are unobstructed by parked vehicles.

Too much waste for your carts? Extra recycling can be taken to the transfer site for no charge, while extra garbage can be disposed of for \$3 per bag.

What's in, What's out?




Not sure how to properly dispose of or recycle something? Some important tips:

- Plastic food containers go in your **Blue Cart**; please make sure it is clean of food and residue
- Some recyclables are only accepted at the transfer site not in the **Blue Cart**, such as electronics, batteries, tires, hazardous waste, housewares
- If using a bag, ensure it is see-thru. Please do NOT use black bags (e.g. for shredded paper)
- Use compostable or paper bags, not plastic, for the Green Cart
- Paper towels are compostable! They go in your Green Cart
- Styrofoam and chip bags go in your Black Cart
