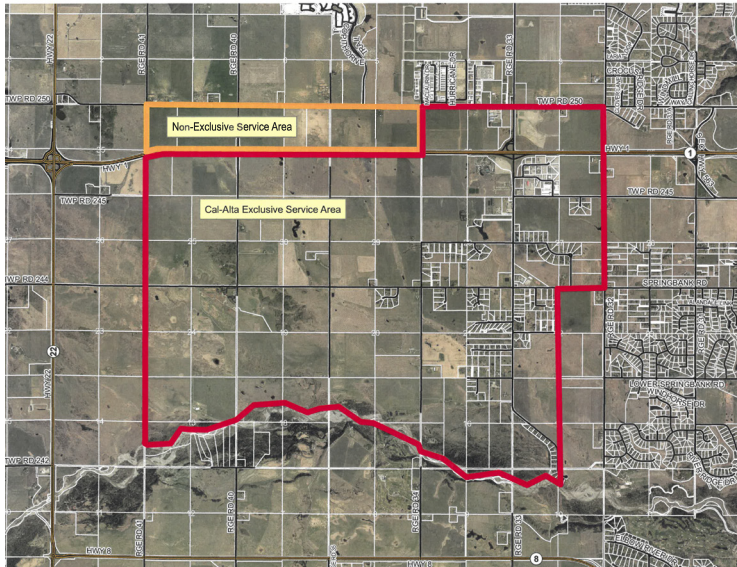


# PUBLIC NOTICE

## Notice of Proposed Franchise Agreement

Public Notice is hereby given pursuant to sections 45(3) and 606 of the *Municipal Government Act* for the proposed grant of a water utility franchise agreement, as well as the accompanying Bylaw C-8015-2020 respecting the grant of an exclusive water services franchise agreement to Calalta Waterworks Ltd. throughout the following area of Rocky View County:



Pursuant to the *Municipal Government Act*, Rocky View County has the ability to:

- Grant a right, exclusive or otherwise, to a person to provide a utility service in all or part of the municipality, for not more than 20 years;
- Grant a right, exclusive or otherwise, to use the municipality's property, including property under the direction, control, and management of the municipality, for the construction, operation, and extension of a public utility in the municipality for not more than 20 years; and
- Charge a fee, rate, or toll for the use of its property, including property under the direction, control, and management of the municipality for the purpose of operating the utility.

For clarity, the franchise area shall exclude areas already serviced by other water providers, and accordingly the franchise agreement and accompanying Bylaw shall not interrupt the continued existing services provided through private water wells or water haul service, or water haul service during any periods of interruptions to the provision of services by the franchisee.

### Important Information:

1. The proposed bylaw and franchise agreement will be considered by Rocky View County Council at the February 25, 2020 Council Meeting, which will begin at 9:00 a.m. at the County Office located at 262075 Rocky View Point, Rocky View County, Alberta, T4A 0X2.
2. A copy of the draft franchise agreement and the accompanying bylaw C-8015-2020 is available for inspection at the County Office or on the website at [www.rockyview.ca](http://www.rockyview.ca)
3. Bylaw C-8015-2020 is not subject to petition under sections 222 – 226 and 231 of the *Municipal Government Act*, as only the franchise agreement is required to be advertised. In lieu of

petitions, any concerns, objections, or support may be filed with the approval process conducted by the Alberta Utilities Commission pursuant to its forthcoming advertisement of the Notice of Application for approval of the franchise agreement.
