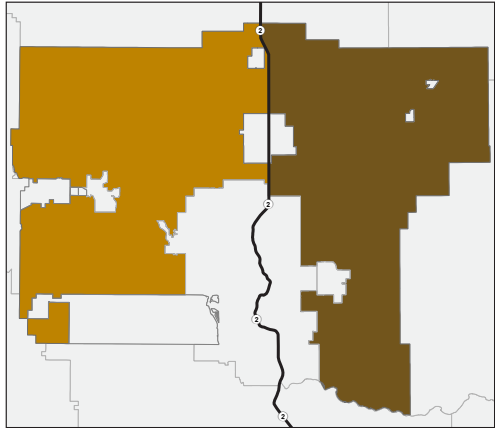


Changes to Rocky View County Fire Ban Regions

Effective July 1, Fire Advisories and Bans in Rocky View County will be issued using East and West regions, with Highway 2 acting as the dividing border.

Previously these conditions were issued for the County as a whole, covering a large geographic area with differing weather conditions and moisture levels.

Now, the County can more specifically target a fire ban or advisory for one region separately, or apply to the County as a whole when necessary.
