ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND ENHANCEMENT ACT
NOTICE OF APPLICATION

In accordance with the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act (EPEA)*, Rocky View County has applied to Alberta Environment and Parks for a renewal of a waterworks approval located in NE-13-023-05-W5M. The waterworks provides a maximum daily flow of 500 m³ potable water to the Hamlet of Bragg Creek and neighbouring area.

Bragg Creek waterworks system treats the surface water from Elbow River and consists of grit removal, enhanced coagulation, flocculation, ultra-membrane filtration, followed by ultraviolet and chlorine disinfection. The wastewater generated in the water treatment plant is disposed to the hamlet's sanitary sewer. The application confirms that the water treatment plant will continue to monitor the water treatment process and quality of treated water and report the monitoring results to Alberta Environment and Parks in accordance with the department's current requirements.

Important Information

2. The written statement of concern should include the following:
 - the application number **006-253845**
 - describe concerns that are relevant to matters regulated by the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*
 - explain how the filer of the concern will be directly affected by the activities proposed in the application
 - provide the legal land location of the land owned or used by the filer where the concerns described are believed to be applicable
 - state the distance between the land owned or used by the filer and the site in the application
 - contact information including the full name and mailing address of the filer. Please provide a telephone number and/or email address for ease of contact.
3. Environment and Parks will review each written statement of concern, seek more information if needed, and notify each filer by letter of the decision to accept or reject their written submission as a valid statement of concern. The Public Notice of this application will also be posted on the Department's website at <https://avw.alberta.ca/PublicNoticesViewer.aspx>.
4. Statements of concern submitted regarding this application are public records which are accessible by the public and the applicant. Failure to file a statement of concern may affect the right to file a Notice of Appeal with the Environmental Appeals Board.
