Located approximately 0.8 km (1/2 mile) north of Township Road 274, west east side of Range Road 51, and 8.1 km (5 miles) east of the Municipal District of Big Horn.

- 2. If you are unable to attend the public hearing you may make a written submission on the bylaw that affects you. Your name, your municipal address or legal land description, and the bylaw number must be included with your submission.
 - a. Written submissions must be received by the deadline indicated on this notice. Written submissions received after the deadline indicated on this notice may only be provided to Council as part of the public hearing if approved through a resolution of Council.

- 3. Due to ongoing concerns with COVID-19, this meeting will be held via video conference and a livestream will be available on the day of the meeting on the Rocky View County website at www.rockyview.ca. Members of the public who would normally provide submissions in person at the public hearing may provide their submissions as noted below:
 - a. If it was your intention to appear in person to present in favor or in opposition of the application during the public hearing, you may submit a pre-recorded video or audio presentation to be played during the public hearing. Pre-recorded presentations can be no longer than 5 minutes if you are speaking on behalf of yourself and 5 minutes if you are speaking on behalf of a group.
 - The video or audio presentation must include your name and the municipality in which you live, and if you are speaking on behalf of a group you must also provide the names and municipalities of the people you are speaking on behalf of. Files must be submitted to the following link https://app.box.com/f/f27dcfa5a49e4bfe906aeb9f4c7460d3 and must be submitted no later than noon the day before the public hearing.
 - b. If it was your intention to appear in person to provide submissions in favor or in opposition of the application during the public hearing, you may also submit an email live during the public hearing to be distributed during the public hearing. Your email submission must include the bylaw number in the subject line and your first and last name and municipal address or legal land description in the body of the email.
 - Email submissions must be sent to PublicHearings@rockyview.ca as early as 9:00am on the day of the public hearing or during the public hearing. Council will be provided time to review email submissions during the public hearing. Emails received after the appropriate portion of the public hearing (in favour or in opposition) will not be provided to Council for consideration.
- A public hearing will be held at the Rocky View County Council meeting that will be livestreamed, on the date indicated.
