In accordance with the *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act*, Rocky View County has applied to Environment and Protected Areas for a renewal to an existing approval for the Watermark at Bearspaw development located in the SE 18-25-2-W5M, in Rocky View County.

The Watermark wastewater treatment plant consists of fine screening, wastewater flow equalization, membrane bioreactor, ultra violet (UV) disinfection and chemical phosphorus removal. Discharge of the treated effluent is through a pipe which runs through the City of Calgary land to the Bow River. The current average design flow is 350m³ per day.



- 2. The written statement of concern should include the following:
 - the application number 006-253877
 - describe concerns that are relevant to matters regulated by the Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act
 - explain how the filer of the concern will be directly affected by the activities proposed in the application
 - provide the municipal address and/or legal land location of the land owned or used by the filer where the concerns described are believed to be applicable

- state the distance between the land owned or used by the filer and the site in the application
- contact information including the full name and mailing address of the filer. Please provide a telephone number and/or email address for ease of contact.
- 3. Environment and Protected Areas will review each written statement of concern, seek more information if needed, and notify each filer by letter of the decision to accept or reject their written submission as a valid statement of concern.
- 4. Statements of concern submitted regarding this application are public records which are accessible by the public and the applicant. Failure to file a statement of concern may affect the right to file a Notice of Appeal with the Environmental Appeals Board.
