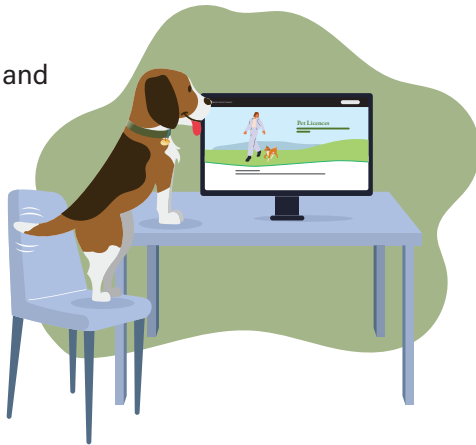
Annual dog licence renewals are in the mail.

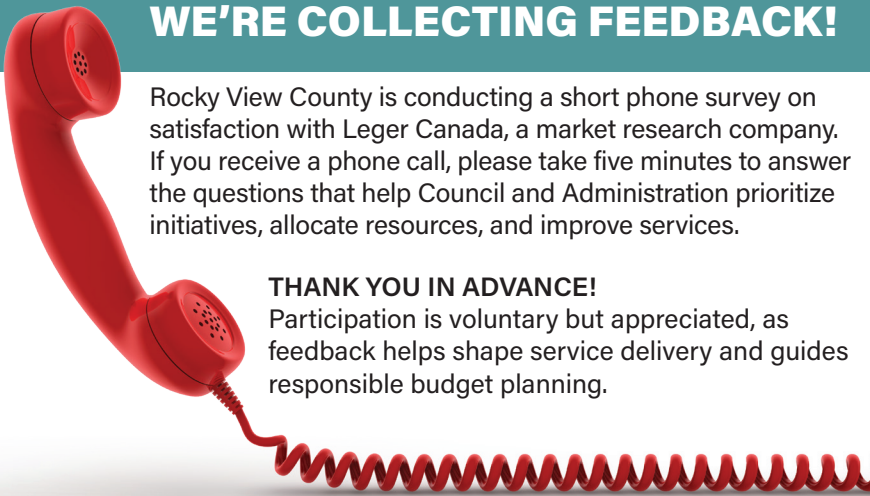
