## 4 BYLAW C-8653-2025

The new plan will replace the existing Municipal Development Plan, known as the County Plan, which was first adopted in 2013.

- 2. Anyone who believes they are affected by any of the proposed bylaws noted above will be provided an opportunity to present to Council on the proposed bylaw through one of the methods provided for in Rocky View County's *Procedure Bylaw*.
- 3. The public hearing will be live streamed and a recording will be made available after the meeting.
- 4. To make an in-person presentation, you may attend the public hearing at the date, time, and location indicated on this public notice. If your inperson presentation includes a written or visual component, you must bring at least 15 copies to the public hearing for distribution.
- 5. If you would like to present or provide verbal comments, but are unable to attend the public hearing in-person, you may request to present electronically through Microsoft Teams by emailing <a href="mailto:legislativeservices@rockyview.ca">legislativeservices@rockyview.ca</a> no later than noon the day before the public hearing. If you are presenting electronically, you cannot also submit a pre-recorded audio/visual submission.
- 6. You may also submit a pre-recorded audio or video presentation to be played during the public hearing if you are unable to attend the public hearing in-person. Pre-recorded audio or video submissions can be no longer than 5 minutes if you are speaking on behalf of yourself and 10 minutes if you are speaking on behalf of a group. If you have submitted a pre-recorded audio or video presentation, you cannot also present in person or electronically.
- 7. Pre-recorded audio or video presentations must include your name, as well as an indication of where you live in proximity to the subject of the public hearing, preferably in the form of a municipal address or legal land description, as well as the names of anyone you are presenting on behalf of. - 8. In addition to presenting in-person, presenting electronically, or providing a pre-recorded audio or visual presentation, you may make a written submission on the bylaw that affects you. Your written submission must include your name, the applicable bylaw or file number, and an indication of where you live in proximity to the subject of the public hearing, preferably in the form of a municipal address or legal land description.
- 9. Written submissions must be received by the deadline indicated on this public notice. Written submissions received before the indicated deadline will be provided to Council and the public in advance of the public hearing. Written submissions received after the indicated deadline may be accepted and provided to Council at the public hearing if approved through a resolution of Council during the public hearing.
