Operational, Capital, Community Enhancement, and Emergency funding opportunities are available to non-profit organizations serving County residents.

All eligible applications are presented to the Recreation Governance Committee (RGC) for approval, which is a Committee appointed by Rocky View County Council.

Community Recreation & Culture Grant Funding Policy

The Grant Program is governed by the Community Recreation & Culture Grant Funding Policy C-317.

Eligible Organizations

Non-Profit Organizations that serve County residents

Capital funding is available for Neighbouring Municipal Governments and School Boards

Eligibility Criteria

- To be eligible for operational funding, organizations must
 - Demonstrate financial need
 - Serve County residents
 - Align with County recreation plans

Policy C-317 (Pg. 3-6)

Eligible Expenses:

- Construction costs
- Repairs
- Renovations
- Studies that support new or expansion

Capital Projects:

- Small Capital Project: Up to \$500,000
- Medium Capital Project: \$500,001 to \$1,000,000
- Large Capital Project: Over \$1,000,000

Capital Project	Cost Sharing Program
Facilities located within Rocky View County	
Small Total project cost is \$500,000 or less	50% funding required
Medium Total project cost is between \$500,001 & \$1 Million	30% funding required
Large Total project cost is over \$1 Million	15% funding required
Facilities located within a Neighbouring Municipality	
All projects for amenities located in neighbouring municipalities	75% funding required, which could include a contribution from the municipality

Operational Funding

Eligible Expenses:

- Utilities, Maintenance, Rental, Insurance Costs etc.
- Programming Costs
- Salaries and Wages (Oct 2023 amendment)

Policy C-317 (Pg. 9-12)

Maximum \$7,500

Categories:

- Heritage Awareness
- Volunteer Development
- Arts and Culture
- Community Benefit

Eligible Expenses:

- Program/Project/Event related costs:
 - Supplies and materials
 - Rentals
 - Insurance
 - Marketing Materials

2025 Amendments:

- Maintenance:
 - Standard maintenance is ineligible
 - Over and above standard maintenance is eligible
- Parks Tribute Program Policy reference added
