Protect Your Sewer System What goes down should stay down!

Only flush human waste and toilet paper. As obvious as this may seem, sewer systems are seeing an uptake in the number of *non-disintegrable products* causing problems in the systems. The most common cause of sewer backups are blocked pipes by non-biodegradable products being flushed down the toilet. Clogged pipes can cause damage to your plumbing and home interior, health and environmental hazards, and causes foul odours.

Flush using only toilet paper, single or double, so it goes down without any trouble!

What to do with your Fats, Oils & Grease

Wipe grease from cooking equipment with a paper towel or pour it into a container so it can cool and harden before disposal. Then dispose of it in your compost bin or garbage.

What are examples of fats, oils and grease?

- Butter and oils
- Gravy, meat grease/pan drippings
- · Cooking oils
- Salad dressings and condiments
