The Process

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Paid Per Call candidates must live or work within a 15-minute drive from the community in which they volunteer.
- 18 years of age or older
- Class 5 (non GDL) license
- Minimal infractions on a 5-year commercial driver's abstract
- Satisfactory completion of a medical examination
- Clean Criminal Record
- Able to lift and carry heavy gear
- Vision, hearing, movement, and coordination adequate to handle firefighting tasks.

1. APPLY

Visit rockyview.ca/careers, when there is a competition open, complete the questionnaire and upload your resume, cover letter, and any related certificates.


2. INTERVIEW

Once your application is reviewed, you may be contacted for an interview. You need to bring the contact information for three references.

3. BACKGROUND CHECKS

Driver's Abstract

Fill out a Driver Abstract Consent Form (will be provided) and the County will pull an abstract on your behalf. If you have lived outside of Alberta in the past 5 years, you must submit abstracts from the other province(s).



3. BACKGROUND CHECKS CONT'D

Criminal Record Check

This is obtained from the RCMP or city police closest to your residence. Make sure to indicate that you require a vulnerable sector check. We can supply you with a letter which indicates that you require the check for volunteer purposes and they will complete it at no charge (RCMP) or a reduced charge (Calgary Police Service). Check the city's website for which offices conduct checks. The check must be from within six months of the date of your interview.

Medical Check

You will be booked for a medical check at Ovation in Airdrie which completes medical checks for all Rocky View County firefighters. The check is confidential and no personal information is divulged. You must receive a "fit or duty" result to move forward.



4. NEXT STEPS

The references you provide at your interview will be checked. If everything in your application is found to be in good order, your file will be forwarded for approval. If approved, an offer will be sent.

Being a PPC Firefighter is very rewarding but it comes with 2 am call-outs in winter and stepping away from gatherings. Be sure to think carefully one more time before accepting the offer.

5. ORIENTATION

Upon acceptance of the offer, you will be scheduled for a half day corporate and health and safety orientation. You are only eligible to attend at the station after you have completed orientation.



6. FIRST 3+ MONTHS

Uniform and Protective Equipment (PPE)

Each recruit will be sized and provided with their initial uniform by the department's Logistics Coordinator. There may be a delay in getting some sizes if they aren't in stock. You will also get suited with your firefighting protective gear.

Training


You will attend regular evening training at the station:

Irricana: Every Tues

Langdon: 1st, 3rd, & 5th Wed or Thurs each month

Madden: 2nd & 4th Mon each month

To build your skills, you will begin NFPA 1001 Level 1 training (basic firefighting skills). You will be expected to attend training on Saturday and Sunday for 4 weekends within the first 3 months (approximately every second weekend). Full attendance is required.
