The Development Permit application for Dwelling, Single Detached (existing), relaxation to the minimum rear yard setback requirement has been **conditionally-approved** by the Development Officer subject to the listed conditions below (**PLEASE READ ALL CONDITIONS**):

Description:

1. That the Dwelling, Single Detached (existing), shall be permitted to remain on the subject property, in accordance with the application and approved real property report prepared by *Lovse Surveys Ltd.* (File No.: 2605006URP), dated May 6, 2026, as amended, including:
 - i. That the minimum rear yard setback requirement for the existing deck shall be relaxed from **6.00 m (19.68 ft.)** to **5.89 m (19.32 ft.)**, including the *Land Use Bylaw C-4841-97* (as regulated by Direct Control District 129) permitted allowance of the deck encroachment from 8.00 m (26.25 ft.) to 6.00 m (19.68 ft.).

Advisory:

- That any other federal, provincial, or County permits, approvals, and/or compliances, are the sole responsibility of the Applicant/Owner.

If Rocky View County does not receive any appeal(s) from you or from an adjacent/nearby landowner(s) by **Tuesday, August 4, 2026**, a Development Permit may be issued, unless there are specific conditions which need to be met prior to release. If an appeal is received, then a Development Permit will not be issued unless and until the decision to approve the Development Permit has been determined by the County's Subdivision and Development Appeal Board.
