For deadline that falls on a weekend or statutory holiday, applications will be accepted until the end of the next business day.

County Administration will present eligible applications to the Recreation Governance Committee (RGC) for consideration. The Committee conditionally approves funding requests in February each year, pending the Langdon Special Tax Bylaw approval in late April. Approved funding is available in late July.
