Vacancies to Fill	Term of Appointment	Number of Meetings
Up to 2 members at large	2 or 3 years	At least two meetings per year; additional meetings may be scheduled

To be eligible to serve as a member on the Committee, you must be:

- a resident of Langdon
- at least 18 years old on the day of appointment
- not currently employed by, or not have been employed for the previous 24 months before the day of appointment, by any of the following:
 - Rocky View County
 - RCMP or any other police force
 - a peace officer agency
 - any provincial ministry responsible for policing, including the Ministry of Justice

Anyone appointed to the Committee must pass an enhanced security check which includes a conflict of interest declaration and review, criminal records check, and in some situations verification of academic and professional credentials and a review of financial records.
